

Schedule of an typical day on Hillel's Hurricane Katrina Alternative Breaks

- 7:00 am** Rise and shine
- 7:30 am** One campus begins preparing breakfast
One campus lays out food for lunch—to be made and taken to work site
- 8:00 am** One campus stays back to clean—bathrooms, showers, dining area
- 8:15 am** Load buses to work site
- 9:00 am** Arrive at work site—meet with construction supervisor, organize tools, etc.
- 9:15 am** Begin work
- 12:00 pm** Eat lunch—lunch can be decided on site as to when you want to break; you can break in shifts.
- 2:30 pm** One campus will leave the work site to prepare dinner.
