

# Your Personal College Visit Checklist

Use this checklist to make the most out of your campus visits!

You can use it digitally or you're welcome to print as many copies as you wish.

- When you are setting up your campus visit with the Admissions Office, ask if a stop at Hillel is included in the official campus tour. If not, reach out to the Hillel on campus to schedule a separate tour. You can find contact information for every Hillel by visiting [Hillel.org/find-a-hillel](https://www.hillel.org/find-a-hillel).
- Visit the Hillel on campus!
  - Make a list of questions that cover what's important to you and your student's Jewish experience at Hillel. Some topics may include:
    - What are Hillel's offerings for Shabbat and other holidays?
    - What Jewish education programming does Hillel offer?
    - Does Hillel run any Birthright Israel and/or Immersive Breaks trips?
    - What are the Jewish Greek Life options on campus? (AEPi, ZBT, and SAM fraternities; AEPi and SDT sororities)
    - What are the Kosher dining options on campus?
    - How shabbat-friendly is campus?
    - Does Hillel help with roommate matching for Jewish students?
- Ask the Hillel to connect you to speak with a current Jewish student or tour campus with a Jewish student. This firsthand perspective is invaluable!
- Ask about other Jewish or Israel-related student organizations on campus.
- Ask if there is a Jewish Studies major/minor offered at the college, and if there are Hebrew language courses taught. You can also ask to get connected to a faculty member in the department to learn more.

If you are on campus long enough, ask the Hillel if there's any programming being offered that day that you can stay for!
